Day 1 | AMSTERDAM (Sunday, August 2, 2026)

Welcome to Amsterdam! As known as the "Venice of the North" this amazing and elegant city welcomes you right from the heart! Your beautiful tour starts with a meet and greet at the reception of the hotel where the Tour Leader will explain the details and you get to meet your fellow travelers. Make sure your camera roll has enough space as every corner of the cities you're about to see will truly amaze you with its history and architecture. The Dutch love to surround themselves with beauty and it shows. A more fitting country could not have been designed by famous architects. Get inspired by national treasures from Dam square to the romantic Amsterdam channels and world-famous art pieces located everywhere you go and realize you can see them with your own eyes finally. European dream starts now!



This week you will be taken care of by our professional tour leaders that will guide you through the history, traditions, and cuisine of this fabulous European culture brought to us since the times of the kings.

After the tour meeting with your tour leader, we will do the panoramic city tour. First, we will see Dam Square, the historical city square, and the National monument erected to commemorate the victims of World War II. Also, the Royal Palace, one of the most striking structures in Amsterdam, and the station building on 3 artificial islands are among the place to see. Following seeing those historical regions we will see the Red Light district, famous coffee shops, which has become a symbol of Amsterdam's open and tolerant culture.

After the tour, you will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Amsterdam canals by boat tour. Transfer to the hotel after the tour and overnight at our hotel.

Day 2 | AMSTERDAM (Monday, August 3, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, you will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Marken - Volendam tour. We will go to the city of Volendam to explore the ethnic Dutch culture and traditions in these small fishing towns. We will go to a local cheese factory in Volendam and we will see the making of the famous Dutch Gouda cheeses. We will be able to see the factory of wooden shoes called Klompen, which is also one of the symbols of the Netherlands. While visiting this beautiful typical town where fishermen settled after the 14th century, which attracted artists such as Picasso and Renoir in the 20th century, we will be able to buy all local souvenirs of the Netherlands at affordable prices.



Following the tour, you will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can also join alternatively to the Grand Holland tour.

During this tour, we will see Rotterdam, the second-largest city in the Netherlands and the largest port in the world. The city was rebuilt after the bombing in World War II. We will see the Erasmus bridge in the city, which dazzles with its magnificent, fascinating, and contemporary architecture. Then we will go to the city of The Hague, which is the political and administrative capital of the Netherlands. We will see the city center and a panoramic view. Transfer to the hotel after the tour and overnight at our hotel.

Day 3 | AMSTERDAM - LUXEMBOURG (Tuesday, August 4, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, departure to Luxembourg. On the way to Luxembourg, you can join alternatively to the Cologne and Cochem tour. First, we will go to Cologne city. During the tour we will see the Cologne Cathedral dating from 1248, which has a construction phase of 632 years. This cathedral was famous as a cathedral that could not be finished. Then the Rhein River, one of the most important rivers of Western Europe with a length of 1230 km, is among the places to see. After Cologne, we will go to Cochem city. Here, we will spend an unforgettable time with its medieval castles, castles that are the subject of fairy tales, and extraordinary nature views. After the tour departure to Luxembourg. Upon arrival to Luxembourg, we will do the panoramic city tour. We will see the Palace of the Dukes, which has become a symbol of national independence for Luxembourg, previously serving as a hotel and then rebuilt as a government building. Day 4 | LUXEMBOURG - BRUSSELS (Wednesday, August 5, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, departure to Brussels. Upon arrival panoramic city tour. Brussels, being the capital of the EU and NATO, has an important place in Europe. We will see the Chinese and Japanese houses, which the Chinese gave as a gift to the Belgians because the Belgian king was the first European king to visit China and Japan. The famous Atomium statue consisting of 9 interconnected spheres 102 meters long magnified 165 million times of the atomic nucleus. We will also see Heysel stadium, which has a bitter reputation due to the death of its fans in 1985, then we will go to the city center. We will see the Grand Place, the royal and city hall around it and the shopping centers. Transfer to the hotel after the tour and overnight at our hotel.



Day 5 | BRUSSELS - PARIS (Thursday, August 6, 2026)

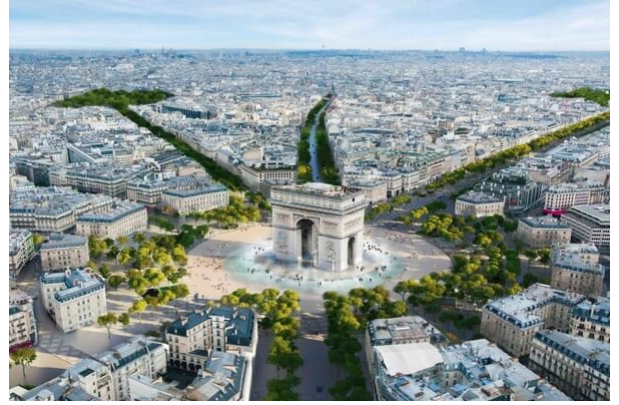
After breakfast at our hotel, departure to Paris. On the way, you can join alternatively to the Gant and Bruges tour. First we will go to Gant. We will see the city that has the most beautiful line of history with the castles and towers of Belgium, which was the center of silk in the 13th century and was introduced to the world by Queen Elizabeth in the 16th century with precious stones. After the tour, we will depart to Bruges. Bruges is the capital of the West Flanders region of Belgium. Also, it is a typical medieval city famous for its chocolates, lace, beer, and canals, where you can shop for souvenirs, taste the chocolates, and sip your beer. After the tour, we depart for Paris. Upon arrival Paris panoramic city tour. The Eiffel Tower, which is the most important symbol of France, is among the first places to see on this tour. Afterward, the world-famous Louvre Museum, the shopping street Champ Elysses, which has been the subject of songs and famous for its most elegant shops and cafes, and the Victory Square, which is called the square here, and the Arc de Triomphe, where you can watch the Paris city view when you reach the top with 224 steps, are among the places to see.

After our boat trip, Notre Dame Cathedral, which is the subject of movies and inspired songs, is following the places to see. Also, among the places to see are Montmartre painters' hill, from which he was inspired while making your portrait by street painters, and the Sacre Coeur church, which contains the largest mosaic in France.



Following our beautiful Paris tour, you will have free time to explore the city sight, or our guests can join alternatively to the Paris by night tour. We will discover a different face in its illuminated mysterious streets. After visiting the specially illuminated magnificent buildings and squares, we will watch the 'light show' of the Eiffel Tower.
