ITINERARY

Day 1 | BELGRADE (Sunday, February 1, 2026)

Welcome to Belgrade! As known as "A City of contrasts and culture" this amazing and elegant city welcomes you right from the heart! Your beautiful tour starts with meet and greet at the reception of the hotel where the Tour Leader will explain you the details and you get to meet your fellow travelers. Make sure your camera roll has enough space as every corner of the cities you're about to see will truly amaze you with its history and architecture. Balkan's love is surrounded themselves with beauty and it shows. A more fitting region could not have been designed by different cultures. Get inspired by national treasures from the Petrovaradin Castle to neoclassical city center and world famous art pieces located everywhere you go and realize you can see them with your own eyes finally. Balkan dream starts now!



This week you will be taken care of by our professional tour leaders who will guide you through history, traditions and cuisine of this fabulous Balkan culture brought to us since the times of the Empires.

After the tour meeting with your tour leader, we will go to the center of Novi Sad. Freedom Square, Svetozar Miletic Statue, Catholic Cathedral, Orthodox Aya Yorgi Cathedral, Aya Nikola Church and Synagogue are among the places to be seen during our walking tour in the city.

Following the tour, you will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Novi Sad and Petrovaradin Castle tour. During this tour, we will go to Novi Sad, the capital of the Voivoda State. We will see the Petrovaradin Castle. Transfer to the hotel, after the tour. Overnight at our hotel.

Day 2 | BELGRADE - SARAJEVO (Monday, February 2, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, we will departure to Sarajevo. On the way, our Belgrade panoramic city tour will start. Stone Square, Libra Square, Republic Square, Saborna Church, Nebojsa Tower, Stefan Lazarevic Monument, Sokullu Mehmet Pasha Fountain, Damat Ali Pasha Tomb, Clock Tower, Istanbul Gate, Military Museum, Castle Square are among the places to see.

Following the panoramic city tour, you will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Zemun and Tito's tomb, Sava, and Danube ship tour. On this tour, we are going to Sava and Danube cruise first. After cruise, we will see the mausoleum of Marasel Tito, the founder of Yugoslavia, of Croatian origin. Then we will visit Zemun. On Zemun, we will see the mansions of the Austro - Hungarian period, the bazaar, the street of taverns, the old theater and the Zemun park. Transfer to the hotel after the tour. In the evening, you can join alternatively to the Bosnian Night tour with dinner and music. Transfer to the hotel in the end of the tour. Overnight at our hotel.

Day 3 | SARAJEVO - MOSTAR - BLAGAJ - POCITEL - TREBINJE (Tuesday, February 3, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, departure to Mostar. On the way, we will start our panoramic Sarajevo city tour. Bascarsija, the most exclusive bazaar in Europe. We will see Kurşunlu Madrasa, which has been operating since the Ottoman period. Then we will see the Clock tower, the Catholic Cathedral in Sarajevo, the Orthodox Churches, and the Jewish Synagogue. Then, the Latin Bridge, where World War I broke out. Then we continue to Mostar. First, we will see the Mostar Bridge on our walking tour in Mostar. Built by the architect Hayreddin in 1556, the bridge is a masterpiece of Ottoman architecture. The bridge was destroyed by the Croatian artillery in the war that took place in 1992, but it was reopened in 2004 with the great contributions of the Republic of Turkey. We will also see the Koska Mehmet Pasha Mosque.



Then our first stop is Pocitel which is protected with its historical texture and known as the Turkish Village. Our second stop is Blagay which is one of the most valuable urban and rural areas of Bosnia and Herzegovina. Transfer to the hotel following the tour and you will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Dubrovnik tour in the evening. Transfer to the hotel in the end of the tour. Overnight at our hotel.

Day 4 | TREBINJE - KOTOR- BUDVA - ST. STEFAN - BAR - SHKODER (Wednesday, February 4, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, departure to Iskodra or Shkoder. On the way, our first stop will be Montenegro, one of the youngest countries in the world, the pearl of the Adriatic Sea. Then we move to Kotor, which is an important historical and natural paradise and tourist attraction center. After a break, our second stop is Budva, one of the most famous holiday centers of the Balkans with its magnificent beaches and colorful nightlife. On the walking tour we will do here, we will visit Stari Grad (old city center) and the castle. Our second stop; the magnificent St. Stefan, which was sold to a multi-billionaire from Singapore after the nationalization of an island that was formerly a settlement for fishermen. You can see St. Stefan's beautiful view from the top. Also we will see Bar. After the tour, we will continue to Iskodra and transfer to the hotel. Overnight at our hotel.



Day 5 | SHKODER - TIRANA - OHRID (Thursday, February 5, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, departure to Ohrid. Our first stop on the way to Shkoder. We will continue to Tirana after the tour. Tirana is the capital of Albania. Ethem Bey Mosque, historical Clock Tower, National Museum, Opera and Ballet Building, Parliament and Prime Ministry Buildings, Presidential Palace and Skanderberg Square are among the places to see. We will continue to Ohrid after the tour. Upon arrival in Ohrid, we will start our panoramic city tour. We will see Cinar Square, Emin Mahmut Mosque, Century Churches, St. Bogorodica Perivlerta, Car Samuel Castle, the Roman-era amphitheater, the Hagia Sophia Church, which is still used for concerts today and St. Panteleymon, which is the most important church of the Byzantine period in Ohrid. Transfer to the hotel after the panoramic city tour and you will have free time to explore the city sight. Overnight at our hotel.



Day 6 | OHRID (Friday, February 6, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, you will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the St. Naum, Resne, Monastery tour with lunch. During this tour we will see, one of the most important saints Monastery of Macedonia, Naum Monastery. Then we will go to Resne. Here we will visit the Palace of Niyazi of Resne, one of the three most famous figures of the Union and Progress, which became famous for its benefits in the Turkish - Greek war. Then, during our Manastir (Bitola) city tour, we will see the old Turkish Bazaar, Bedesten.

Transfer to the hotel after the tour and you will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Macedonian Night tour with dinner and music in the evening. You will taste the Balkan cuisine and experience an unforgettable night. Transfer to the hotel, after the tour. Overnight at our hotel.

Day 7 | OHRID - GOSTIVAR - KALKANDELEN - SKOPJE (Saturday, February 7, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, departure to Gostivar. On the way, our Struga panoramic city tour will start. Then our next stop is Kalkandelen or Tetovo. Tetovo is in the northwest of Macedonia, within the borders of the Polog Region. It is built on the skirts of Sharr Mountain and by the Pena River. It is the third largest city in the country after the capital Skopje and Monastery. In the 14th century, Tetovo, like many other cities in the region, joined the Ottoman Empire. With the Turkish domination, many changes and innovations were seen in the city. In the city, which started to develop in terms of trade, new buildings, and structures such as baths were established. This period also enabled the Muslim population in Tetovo to increase and become the dominant population. In connection with the situation in question, many mosques, masjids, and religious buildings were established in the city. Alaca Mosque, built in 1438, is important in many ways. During the Ottoman Empire, Tetovo was not only an important trade center, but also came to the fore in terms of agriculture and craft. In addition to these, the city also had the feature of a military base. With the declaration of independence of Macedonia from the Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia in 1991, Tetovo has come to the present day within the independent Republic of Macedonia. Among the places to see in and around Tetovo decorated by the Pena River, the old castle, the Leşok Monastery, the historical stone bridge, the Alaca Mosque, an original architectural work built in the 1400s with its colorful decorations, the old Turkish Bath serving as an art gallery by the Pena River, are available. Then we will continue to Skopje. Transfer to the hotel after the tour and overnight at our hotel.



Day 8 I SKOPJE (Sunday, February 8, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, we will go for Skopje panoramic city tour with our guide and private vehicles. Clock Tower, Turkish Bazaar, Mustafa Pasha Mosque, Capan Han, Sulu Han, Stone Bridge. We will walk by watching the old Turkish and Jewish quarters on the side of the river. We will see Macedonia Square, the Ottoman Bridge and Davut Pasha Bath. Then we will go to the old Turkish bazaar and start to see the historical artifacts, where 17 inns were built during the Ottoman period, only 3 inns remain today. After seeing Kursunlu Han and Kapan Han, built in the second half of the 15th century, we will see the clock tower, one of the symbolic works of Skopje and built in the 16th century, and the Sultan Murat Mosque, built in the 14th century.

Following the tour, you will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Matka Canyon tour. On this tour, we will have a pleasant walk accompanied by the nature view. After the tour, transfer to Skopje and end of Kappa Tour services. Thank you for being a Kappa Tour guest and joining our tour. We look forward to seeing you in our next tours.
