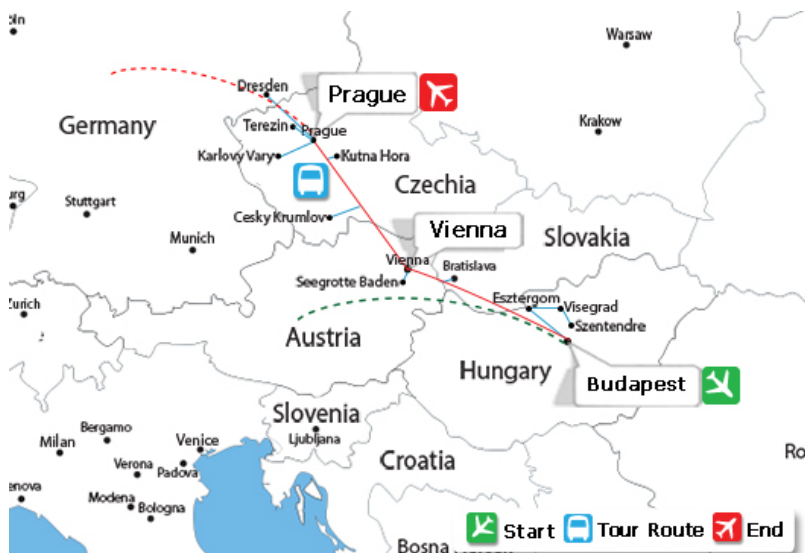

Day 1 | BUDAPEST (Sunday, October 11, 2026)

Welcome to Budapest! As known as "Queen of the Danube" this amazing and elegant city welcomes you right from the heart! Your beautiful tour starts with a meet and greet at the reception of the hotel where the Tour Leader will explain the details and you get to meet your fellow travelers. Make sure your camera roll has enough space as every corner of the city you're about to see will truly amaze you with its history and architecture. Hungarians love to surround themselves with beauty and it shows. A more fitting country could not have been designed by the Danube River. Get inspired by national treasures from the river to historical castles and world-famous art pieces located everywhere you go, and realize you can see them with your own eyes finally. The story of Central Europe starts now!



This week you will be taken care of by our professional tour leaders who will guide you through the history, traditions and cuisine of this amazing Hungarian culture that has been brought to us since the time of the Hungarian Empire.

After meeting with your tour leader, you will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Traditional Hungarian Gypsy night in Budapest with dinner. We will go to the wine cellars region of Budapest in our Gypsy Night tour, where traditional Gypsy music and performances originating from Hungarian and Romanian music based on Western (Vienna classical music), Balkan and Turkish music were made and the most authentic of Budapest, which was opened with the restoration of some of the wine cellars with a total length of 98 km. You will have a wonderful night of fun with the delicious tastes of Hungarian Cuisine while watching Hungarian dances in traditional clothes in the restaurant and dancing to the music of the famous Hungarian Gypsy orchestra. Transfer to the hotel after the tour and overnight at our hotel.

Day 2 I BUDAPEST (Monday, October 12, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, we will depart for a panoramic city tour. Our panoramic city tour It is divided into two parts as the right (Buda) and left (Pest) banks on both sides of the Danube. It is the second largest city in Central Europe after Berlin and one fifth of the Hungarian population lives here. On the left bank of the Danube, modern streets decorated with parks and historical districts stretch around the Buda Castle. The brain of the city and the big districts are in the plain on the right bank of the Danube. Panoramic city tour following the arrival in Budapest. In our panoramic tour we will see; Gellert Hill, where you can watch the whole city from the point of view of a bird, Erzsebet Bridge, Fishermen's Tower, which is on the UNESCO world heritage list and St. Mathias Cathedral. Also, the Chain Bridge, which is the first bridge of the city, the Parliament Building, which draws a magnificent picture, Heroes Square, where the statues of Hungarian kings and reliefs showing their heroism are among the places to see.



Following the tour, you will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Esztergom - Visegrad - Szentendre tour which has lunch and drink includes. First, we will go to see the historical castle of Buda, After the lunch will have the opportunity to buy all the souvenirs of Hungary at affordable prices in Szentendre Artists Village.

In the end of the tour we will have free time win Budapest city or you can join alternatively to the Danube River tour. While sipping our drink on the Danube River, one of the most magnificent rivers in the world, we will have the opportunity to photograph the magnificent structures of Budapest, the Buda and Pest sides from the most beautiful angles, where one of the most beautiful night lights in Europe is made. We will return to the Rome hotel after the tour. Overnight at our hotel.

Day 3 I BUDAPEST - VIENNA (Tuesday, October 13, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, we will depart to Vienna with our bus. On the way, our guests can join alternatively to the Bratislava tour. Bratislava is one of the richest capitals of Europe with a national income of € 25000 per capita. In our tour we will see; the banks of the Bratislava River, the pearl of the Danube, first Turkish traces before the Siege of Vienna from 1529, Bratislava Castle, St. Martin's cathedral, promenade in the old historic city, Grassalkovich Palace, Parliament, the Slovak State Theater. This building is the historical building where Mozart's first concert to Maria Theresa at the age of 6. Following the tour, we will have free time for eating and shopping in the old town center. Then we will continue departure to Vienna. After arrival in Vienna, our panoramic city tour will be start. In our city tour, the first places to see are the famous Viennese Opera House, the University of Vienna which was founded in 1365 by IV. Herzog Rudolf. Also, the famous Parliament Building with its more than a century of history, the Vienna Theater, which houses countless artists of the world, and finally the imperial palace of Vienna in the Hofburg and Museum district are among the places to see.



Transfer to the hotel after the tour. You will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Grizing Taverns tour. In this tour you will find a wonderful night, limited drinks and dinner accompanied by violins, accordions, Viennese songs in one of the most beloved restaurants of the region by going to the Grinzing Hills, which is the entertainment center of Vienna. Transfer to the hotel after the tour. Overnight at our hotel.

Day 4 | VIENNA (Wednesday, October 14, 2026)

After our breakfast at our hotel, you will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Seegrotte city of Baden and Schönbrunn Palace Gardens tour. Among the places to visit in this tour; the famous hunting lodge in Mayerling which is one of the most important architectural structures of the Habsburg Dynasty in the northeast of the city and where the imperial family stayed in summer. After visiting the Schönbrunn Palace Gardens in Hietzing, which is used as a venue, you will have the opportunity to see the most famous street and the cathedral of Vienna during free shopping. Then we will have our lunch fish and salad in the city center.



Transfer to our hotel in the end of the tour. You will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Vienna Concert night tour at the world-famous Vienna Opera and Ballet stage. Transfer to the hotel after the tour. Overnight at our hotel.

Day 5 | VIENNA - PRAGUE (Thursday, October 15, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, departure to Prague. On the way to Prague, you can join alternatively to the Cesky Krumlov tour. Cesky Krumlov, a medieval town, is also a town on the World Heritage List by UNESCO. This charming island looks like an island in the curves of the Vltava River. This is a true medieval city. After the tour we will departure to Prague.



On the way to Prague, you can join alternatively the Kutna Hora tour. We will see the only church in the world, whose interior decoration is made only of human bones, is in Kutna Hora. Moreover, the most important part of this church is the "Schwarzenberg Family" coat of arms, and this coat of arms is Turkish. It consists of the skeleton of a crow that pierces its eye.

After our tour departure to Prague. Prague is the capital and largest city of the Czech Republic. It is located on the Vltava River in Central Bohemia. Prague is also known by names such as "Golden City", "Left Bank of the Nineties", "Fairytale City", "Mother of Cities" and "Heart of Europe".

Panoramic view upon arrival in Prague city tour. During our panoramic city tour, we will see; Prime Minister's Palace, the Chekhov bridge, Paris Street, the Jewish Quarter, the house of the world-famous writer Kafka, the statue of Jan Hus, the Tyn Church and the old Town Hall and the old town square and its beauty, where there are many works like these structures. In addition, we will see the unique, magnificent work of the architect, whose eyes were blinded by the King so that it would never be built again. The Astronomical Clock tower, whose history dates back to the 15th century is also among the place to see.

Transfer to our hotel after the panoramic city tour. You will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Vltava River boat tour with open buffet meals and drinks. Vltava is one of the most aesthetic and elegant flowing rivers of the world, with eight islands and eighteen bridges built on it. The largest is the Charles Bridge dated 1347, stretching throughout the middle of Prague, which has a great share in the formation of the most beautiful images in the world.

Following the tour, you will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Prague by night tour. In this tour, we will see the unique beauty of illuminated Prague. Vitus Cathedral, Astronomical Clock Tower, Presidential Palace, Prague Castle. Then we will go to a restaurant where we will have our dinner. We will transfer to the hotel after the night tour. Overnight at our hotel.

Day 6 I PRAGUE (Friday, October 16, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, you will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Prague Masterpieces tour. On our tour, we will visit the Old Kingdom Palace and the Castle District, the Presidential Palace, St. Vitus Cathedral, the construction of which is built in 600 years, Matias Gate, St. Georg's Church, Toy Museum, King's Road, Charles Bridge, which is one of the oldest bridges in the world with 30 statues of Saints built by the chief architect Peter Parler in the XIII century and closed to traffic. Also, Clementinum Monastery, King Shopping Street, Johannes Kepler's house, St. Nicholas Church, Smetana house, Statue of Jan Hus, the Kinský Palace, where socialism was proclaimed in 1948 and Astronomical clock tower are also among the places to see.



Following the tour, you will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Karlovy Vary tour with lunch. Karlovy Vary is the most frequented and most famous city of European society and statesmen in the 17th and 18th centuries. You will see dozens of magnificent palaces built side by side, the hotel where Ataturk stayed in 1918, the houses of Dvorak, Mozart, Goethe, Beethoven, Pushkin, in the unique nature of the city, thermal springs from which 12 different thermal waters emerge. We will visit the crystal and porcelain galleries and buy them in factory outlets, garnet, amber, and other traditional Czech souvenirs are sold here. We will have time for local shopping. Karlovy Vary is the healthiest city in the world. There are thousands of underground mineral deposits in Karlovy Vary, which is famous for its well-known thermal springs and natural springs.

Transfer to the hotel after the tour. You will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Medieval night with dinner. We will enjoy medieval entertainment, music, and dances in one of Europe's most historical and authentic restaurants from the 14th century.

Day 7 I PRAGUE (Saturday, October 17, 2026)

In this tour, we will see the magnificent city center with its Baroque architecture built on the edge of the Elbe river, Frauenkirche, one of the most important structures of Dresden which the name meaning the place between the two walls, the Zwinger palace with pools, large galleries, pavilions connecting the galleries and the second-largest porcelain museum in the world. Also, Brühl's terrace, King road, Elbe river, the statue of Martin Luther with numerous works that, when he was in danger of being struck by lightning on the way, decided to become a monk and repeatedly caused him to be tried by the church, Hof church, II. Semper Opera, which hosted the premieres of many works by Richard Strauss in the years before World War II and the old town square are among the places to see.



Following the tour, you will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Terezin Camp tour on the way to Dresden. Terezin Camp, which was used as a Nazi Concentration Camp in World War II, will attract the great attention of our guests.

Transfer to the hotel after our tour. You will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Czech night with dinner. We will have a local cuisine dinner and enjoy the Czech entertainment, music, and dances in one of the most famous and authentic restaurants.
