Day 1 | CAIRO (Sunday, January 4, 2026)

Welcome to Cairo! As known as "Capital of the Egyptian civilization" this amazing and elegant city welcomes you right from its heart! Your beautiful tour starts with meet and greet at the reception of the hotel where the Tour Leader will explain you the details and you get to meet your fellow travelers. Make sure your camera roll has enough space as every corner of the cities you're about to see will truly amaze you with its history and architecture. Egyptians have very ancient history that they surrounded themselves with and it shows. A more fitting country could not have been designed by the God of the sun Ra. Get inspired by national treasures from Pyramids to Temples and world famous historical art pieces located everywhere you go and you finally can see them with your own eyes. Egypt dream starts now!



This week you'll be taken care of by our professional tour leaders that will guide you through history, traditions and cuisine of this fabulous culture brought to us since the times of the Pharaohs.

After the tour meeting with your tour leader, you will have free time to explore the city sight. Overnight stay at our hotel.

Day 2 | CAIRO (Monday, January 5, 2026)

After the breakfast at our hotel, you will have free time to explore the city sight or alternatively, our guests can join Cairo, Egyptian Museum, and Pyramids tour. Our first stop will be the Egyptian Museum. Founded in 1857, the museum is considered one of the largest and most important museums in the world. Every artifact obtained during the excavations in the Valley of the Kings is exhibited in the museum. From Tutankhamun's Tomb to the mummy collection, from ancient Egyptian jewelry to royal clothes, this collection fascinates all visitors. The second stop of the day should be Pyramids of Cheops, Khafre, and Menkaure, one of the seven wonders of the world and named after the pharaohs. These 3 pyramids, which were built thousands of years ago and still preserve their mysteries, were designed with a Pythagorean triangle between them. These pyramids, built years before Pythagoras, show that the Egyptians had very advanced knowledge of mathematics and geometry.



After visiting the mysterious pyramids, we will see the Sphinx, whose head is in the shape of a Pharaoh and whose body is in the shape of a lion, representing the rising sun and resurrection for the pharaoh. After visiting the "living statue" Sphinx, which has a temple in its claws, we will have our lunch. After dinner, we will visit the Saqqara Pyramid, also known as the Step Pyramid, located in Memphis, the ancient capital of Egypt. After visiting the Saqqara Pyramid, which is considered the first great stone monument in the world. After our tour, transfer to our hotel dinner and overnight stay at our hotel.

Day 3 | CAIRO - LUXOR (Tuesday, January 6, 2026)

After the breakfast at our hotel, transfer to the airport for our flight to Luxor. Upon arrival in Luxor, we will do our tour of the East Bank. We will see magnificent Temples of Karnak, dating back over 3,000 years. We will walk along the avenue of the Sphinxes and marvel at the Hypostyle Hall with its 134 massive sandstone columns. After exploring this ancient structure, we will embark on the Nile Cruise. In the afternoon, we will visit Luxor Temple to admire the colossal statues of the great pharaoh Ramses II. Next, visit a shop where we can view a brief demonstration of how papyrus paper is made from the papyrus grass. After our tour, transfer to our ship. Dinner and overnight stay at our ship.



Day 4 | LUXOR (Wednesday, January 7, 2026)

After breakfast at our ship, you will have free time to explore the city sight or alternatively, our guests can join Magnificence of the Luxor West Bank tour. We will see the UNESCO listed Valley of the Kings, the necropolis of Thebes and admire the tombs of ancient Egypt's rulers. Then, head to the Temple of Hatshepsut, a colonnaded structure surrounded by cliffs and learn about the life of Queen Hatshepsut, Egypt's famous female ruler. We will visit alabaster factory, where we can view a demonstration of grinding alabaster the old-fashioned way. Browse the extensive collection of alabaster pieces. Conclude the tour at the Colossi of Memnon, two massive stone statues of the Pharaoh Amenhotep II. After the tour return to the ship and continue sailing onward this afternoon. Dinner and overnight stay at our ship.

Day 5 | EDFU - KOM OMBO (Thursday, January 8, 2026)

After breakfast at our ship, we will visit the stunning Temples of Horus in Edfu, considered one of the best preserved of all the Egyptian Temples. It was built during the Ptolemaic times and was completed over a 180-year period. The temple is dedicated to the falcon god Horus, son of Isis and Osiris. Its extravagant design and sheer size is an indication of the country's prosperity at the time. Then we will go for the tour of Greco-Roman Temple of Kom Ombo, dedicated to Horus, the sky god and Sobek, the crocodile god. Admire the fascinating detailed reliefs on the walls. After the tour return to our ship. Dinner and overnight stay at our ship.



Day 6 | ASWAN (Friday, January 9, 2026)

After breakfast at our ship, you will have free time to explore the city sight or alternatively, our guests can join Philae Temple dedicated to the goddess Isis and Felucca ride tour. We will arrive by motorboat and marvel at the Temples beautiful island location. Stop at a local perfume shop. During our visit, we can watch the creation of perfumes. Select a fragrance and choose from a wide selection of glass bottle containers. Continue to the spectacular Aswan High Dam, an engineering miracle when originally constructed in the 1960s. The dam brought an end to the Nile s devastating floods. We will Enjoy a relaxing ride aboard a felucca, the traditional sailboat of Egypt used along the Nile. Glide gently down the river and catch the refreshing breeze while witnessing the beautiful scenery of the Nile Valley. Experience the peace and tranquility of the area during your one hour cruise. After the tour return to our ship. Dinner and overnight stay at our ship.

Day 7 | ASWAN - CAIRO (Saturday, January 10, 2026)

After breakfast at our ship disembarking from our cruise ship. We will have time to explore the city sight until our flight to Cairo. Then, head to the airport for our flight. Transfer to our hotel upon arrival. We will have free time to explore the city sight or alternatively, our guests can join Al-Azhar Mosque and Khan El Khalili bazaar tour. Our first stop is the Al-Azhar Mosque. M.S. The mosque, built in 972, covers an area of 3,000 square meters and is home to Al-Azhar University. Then we will go to Khan El Khalili bazaar. Established in the 14th century, the Khan El-Khalili market in Cairo has always been an important district for cultural and economic activity. After our tour, transfer to our hotel. Overnight stay at our hotel. Al-Azhar Mosque and Khan El Khalili bazaar tour: \$ 40



Day 8 | CAIRO (Sunday, January 11, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, we will leave the rooms and, you will have free time to explore the city sight until your flight, end of Kappa Tour services.
