## Day 1 | CASABLANCA (Sunday, February 1, 2026)

Welcome to Morocco! As known as "Country where the Sahara Desert meets the north African mountains" this amazing country welcomes you right from the heart! Your beautiful tour starts with meet and greet at the reception of the hotel where the Tour Leader will explain you the details and you get to meet your fellow travelers. Make sure your camera roll has enough space as every corner of the cities you're about to see will truly amaze you with its history, culture, and nature. Morocco has very ancient history that surrounded themselves with and it shows.

Morocco has a traditional architecture that developed in the Islamic period 7th century and after. Get inspired by national treasures from Marrakech traditional streets to world famous historical places located everywhere you go, and realize you can see them with your own eyes finally. Morocco dream starts now!

This week you will be taken care of by our professional tour leaders who will guide you through history, traditions and cuisine of this fabulous culture brought to us 1,000 years ago.

After the tour meeting with your tour leader, you will have free time to explore the city sight. Dinner and overnight in our hotel.



## Day 2 | CASABLANCA - RABAT - MEKNES - FES (Monday, February 2, 2026)

After the breakfast at our hotel, departure to Fes. On the way you can join alternatively to the Rabat and Meknes tour. In Rabat, Hassan Tower, Mohammed V Mausoleum, and the Royal Palace are among the places we will see. The exploration of Rabat begins at the exterior of the Dar al-Makhzen Palace, the residence of Morocco's King. Then on to the Mohammed V Mausoleum, built in traditional Moroccan style, dedicated to the founder of modern Morocco. Observe the minaret of the Great Mosque and the towering 12th-century red sandstone Hassan Tower. Afterward, visit Kasbah des Oudaias in the old part of the city, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Time to stroll along the lanes of the Andalusian gardens, designed by the French during the colonial period. Then we continue to city of Meknes, a UNESCO World

Heritage Site that rose to glory under the rule of the Sultan Moulay Ismail. View the monumental horseshoe-shaped Bab Mansour gate. This beautifully patterned gate with its priceless mosaics, lavish tiles and inscriptions is considered one of the most beautiful gates in North Africa. After an introduction to the historic medina of Meknes, it's on to lunch in the foothills of the Atlas Mountains. At an immaculate vineyard with its beautifully manicured gardens and traditional fountains, linger for a wine tasting of their white and red wines. Then the driver takes you to mystical Fez, one of the four imperial cities of Morocco. Transfer to the hotel in the end of the tour. Overnight at our hotel.

## Day 3 | FES (Tuesday, February 3, 2026)

After the breakfast at our hotel, we will go for our panoramic city tour. Explore medieval Fez, founded in the 8th century by Moulay Idriss I. Enter the blue Moorish-style Bab Bou Jeloud gate that takes you into the 1200-year-old streets of the Old Quarter (Fez el-Bali) leading to a maze of narrow winding lanes and countless souks selling fragrant spices and endless arrays of local crafts. Stop to see the workers in the famous tanneries. On to view the exterior of 9th-century Karaouine, and Nejjarine Square with its elaborate mosaic tile fountain. After lunch in a restored riad, enjoy a specially arranged Henna ceremony (Hennaya) where artists paint symbolic motifs on your hands or feet. A Moroccan tea ceremony follows this. Transfer to our hotel in the end of the tour. Overnight at our hotel.



## Day 4 | FES - VOLUBILIS - MARRAKECH (Wednesday, February 4, 2026)

After the breakfast at our hotel, departure to Marrakech. On the way you can join alternatively to the Volubilis tour. This morning the dramatic well-preserved Roman ruins of Volubilis, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, offers a unique glimpse into ancient Morocco. View a series of mansions, monuments and olive mills surrounded by remnants of the city's defense walls. The most notable highlights include the beautifully preserved Triumphal Arch of Caracalla, a series of exquisite mosaics and colorful tiles depicting Roman mythology. After our tour, we will depart for Marrakech. Upon our arrival in Marrakech, panoramic city tour. We will start to explore Marrakech, which will take you centuries ago with its narrow streets. Ba Ahmed's Bhia Palace, Koutoubia Minaret, one of the 800 year old examples of Moresque Architecture, Majorella gardens, Souks and Jma El Fna city square called Miracles Courtyard are among the places we will see.



Transfer to our hotel in the end of the tour. You will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Chez Ali Morocco show night tour with dinner. Dinner accompanied by musicians and folklore performances at the world famous and Moroccan magnificent show by horse cavalry. Enjoy the amazing welcome when you arrive with a Moroccan folklore, then lead it to the restaurant to enjoy a beautiful moments. Taste the Moroccan delicious gastronomy then watch the Fantasia and belly dancing, folk music, acrobatics, and fireworks. We will return to the hotel after the tour. Overnight at our hotel.

## Day 5 | MARRAKECH - ESSAOUIRA - MARRAKECH (Thursday, February 5, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, you will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the World Heritage Essaouira tour. Located on the shores of the Atlantic Ocean, this city that reminds us of old Positano at first glance is one of the world-famous old Portuguese cities. Listed as a World Heritage Site by Unesco, this city is a fishing port on the Atlantic coast and a seaside town where art and culture are intertwined. The city's castle, fishing port and Medina, which was built by adapting the old Roman cities, are among the places to visit. You can explore the city and do pleasant shopping among the narrow winding streets that you can't get enough of. We will return to the hotel after the tour. Overnight stay at our hotel.

## Day 6 I MARRAKECH (Friday, February 6, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, you will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Atlas Mountains and Valleys tour with lunch. A day to explore the stunning scenery of the Atlas Mountains is a highlight of any trip to Marrakech. You get to see how different life is in the villages of the valleys and what a truly beautiful country Morocco is. Hear about Morocco's rural way of life as you drive into the foothills of the Atlas Mountains. Admire the snow-tipped peaks as you head further into the spectacular range, and after roughly an hour, arrive at the Ourika Valley. Ogle the greenery and terraced slopes and stop to admire the Ourika's stunning waterfalls a lovely contrast to the rugged mountain slopes. Walk to the falls and take photos of the tumbling waters, and then visit a local Argan Oil Co-operative, where Berber women extract the oil of Argan nuts to use in cooking and cosmetics. Then visit a bio aromatic garden where plants and herbs are cultivated for medicinal, aromatic and decorative purposes. Drive on into the beautiful Oukaimeden Valley. Climb to 5,900 feet up a winding mountain road, passing Berber villages of stone and adobe perched on the steep slopes. Meet your welcoming Berber hosts and enjoy a homemade lunch. Continue to the third valley the Asni Valley high in the mountains. View Mt Toubkal, at 13,665 feet and pass the Asni's apple, walnut, peach and almond groves. Afterward, head toward the fourth valley that is Asni, famous by its fruit trees, have your camera ready to take pictures of highest peak in North Africa, the Toubkal mount with 13 665 feet. We will return to the hotel after the tour. Overnight at our hotel.

## Day 7 I MARRAKECH - CASABLANCA (Saturday, February 7, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, departure to Delhi. On the way to Delhi we will stop for some photos at the graceful sandstone Qutab Minar Victory Tower. It was built in the 12th century as a Victory Tower by Qutb-ud-din Aibak who later became the Sultan of Delhi. The minaret has been added to over the years and attempts were made to replicate and improve on it but all in vain. The remnants of this failed attempt can be seen nearby. The Qutub Minar is the tallest brick minaret in the world, standing at a height of 72.5 metres. It takes 379 steps to reach the top of the tower but the passage is closed to tourists. The minaret has been struck by lightning, which damaged an entire story in the 14th century, although this has since been repaired and replaced. The favourite part of the tower is its Arabic inscriptions that demonstrate the beauty of Kufic calligraphy. Transfer to the hotel after the visit. Dinner and overnight in our hotel.



## Day 8 I CASABLANCA (Sunday, February 8, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, we will leave the rooms and you will have free time to explore the city sight until your flight in the end of Kappa Tour services. Thank you for being a Kappa Tour guest and joining our tour. We look forward to seeing you in our next tours.
