Day 1 | ROME (Sunday, August 23, 2026)

Benvenuti a Roma! As known as "Capital of the World" this amazing and elegant city welcomes you right from the heart! Your Bellissimo tour starts with a meet and greet at the reception of the hotel where the Tour Leader will explain the details and you get to meet your fellow travelers. Make sure your camera roll has enough space as every corner of the cities you're about to see will truly amaze you with its history and architecture. Italians love to surround themselves with beauty and it shows. A more fitting country could not have been designed by Michelangelo himself. Get inspired by national treasures from Fountain of Love to Colosseum and world-famous art pieces located everywhere you go and realize you can see them with your own eyes finally. La dolce vita starts now!

This week you will be taken care of by our professional tour leaders who will guide you through the history, traditions, and cuisine of this fabulous European culture brought to us since the times of the Great Roman Empire.

After the tour meeting with your tour leader, you will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Grande Romantica night tour. On this tour, we will go to Giannicolo Hill, one of the most romantic and beautiful hills of Rome, which is built on 7 hills. After watching the unique view of Rome, we take our bus to one of the most historical districts of Rome, where there are different beautiful restaurants, and we have free time for dinner there. After our free time, we will arrive at Navona Square to see Rome and the Tiber River at night. Transfer to the hotel after the tour. Overnight at our hotel.

Grande Romantica Night tour: \$ 30

Day 2 | ROME (Monday, August 24, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, we will depart for a panoramic city tour. Via del Conciliazione, Piazza San Pietro, Vatican, Piazza Venezia, Via Dei Fori Imperiali which is the street famous for Mussolini's private opening, and the Colosseum Amphitheater, the symbol of Rome's power, will be seen panoramically our tour will be finished in the center of the city in Teatro Marcello square.

Following the panoramic city tour by bus, you will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Roman Masterpieces tour. On this tour, we will see every step another masterpiece of Rome by walking for 4 hours we will see each corner of the old city. Venezia Square, then the Spanish Steps and Spanish Square, which opens to the streets where the famous shops are located. Then we go to see Fontana di Trevi (Fountain of Love), we walk to the Pantheon, one of the most interesting centers in Rome, and the famous Navona Square, famous for its statues and fountains here we will have some free time for lunch. Then we go to Vatican City. Here we see San Pietro square after seeing the masterpieces of the giant artists of the Renaissance, Leonardo Da Vinci, and Michelangelo, in San Pietro, the largest church in the world.

After the tour, you will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Castel Romano Outlet Center and Castel Gondolfo tour. On this tour, you will find the opportunity to shop in Castel Romano, one of the biggest Outlet centers in Rome, and you will have the opportunity to see the summer palace of the Pope, the magnificent medieval architecture, and the lake view at Castel Gondolfo. We will return to the Rome hotel in the end of the tour. Overnight at our hotel.

Day 3 | ROME (Tuesday, August 25, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, you will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Napoli Pompei tour. We will go to the south of the country to see the amazing Naples and the historic city of Pompei. Our tour will start with the legend of Pompeii. Seeing the smoke coming out of the Vesuvius volcano in 79 A.D., the people crowded into the ships and tried to escape, never to return. After the shaking that lasted for 20 minutes, the rising sea threw the ships into the hot lava and destroyed them. The people who stayed in the city fled to their houses, the deadly gases coming out of the volcano caused them to suffocate in an instant. Then the ashes from the volcano covered the city and Pompei disappeared with its 20,000 inhabitants. For about 2,000 years, those magnificent houses, villas, frescoes, statues, wall paintings were buried in ashes.

When the archaeologists discovered the city, they found the baked bread in the oven and the dead, petrified of whatever they were doing at the time. Pompeii, with its agora, theater, and temples, is the Italian city of Ephesus, the magnificent installation of a destroyed city unearthed during excavations. Seeing these petrified people accompanied by an Italian and English guide is the most important cultural trip to learn about life in those days.

After the tour, we have a lunch break in Pompeii, and then we will arrive in Naples following the Via Nuova Marina Port Road. After a tour of Chiesa della Pietà dei Turchini, the oldest cathedral in the city, free time to shop in Via Medina, the city's central shopping street. The city of Naples established in its place invites you to the city of Sophia Loren. Hosting approximately 20 million tourists a year, Pompeii and Naples is an image you will remember for many years. We will return to the Rome hotel in the end of the tour. Overnight at our hotel.

Naples, Pompei tour: \$ 120

Day 4 | ROME - FLORENCE (Wednesday, August 26, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, departure to Florence. On the way, you can join alternatively to the Orvieto tour. Orvieto is one of the world's most important medieval heritage. The sun of gothic and baroque art with white and black marbles. After we arrive in the city called falcon hill by Funicolare, Orvieto with its wine cellars and authentic view, you will breathe the smell of 1290 years in all its streets, you will say that you wish we had stayed here for one night. Upon arrival in Florence, our panoramic city tour begins. On this tour, Ponte Vecchio is like a landmark to show the location of Florence. The covered bridge, which dates back to the 14th century, is unique. On both sides of the road crossing the bridge to the other side, there are jewelry stores that have been here since the 16th century. The corridor above the shops connects the Pitti Palace and the Uffizi. Sculptures in Signoria Square have turned the square into an open-air museum. On the left, the large statue on the horse is of Cosimo the Little (Medici), made by Giovanni da Bologna. The bronze plate next to the Neptune (Poseidon) Fountain (1576) indicates that the priest Savonarola was cremated here. In front of Palazzo Vecchio are the glorious Marzocco, or the Lion of Florence, the famous Judith and Holophernes sculptures by Donatello, and copies of Davide and Hercules by Michelangelo. Duomo Cathedral, San Giovanni Battista Baptistery, Uffizi Gallery, Palazzo Vecchio are among the places to see. Transfer to our hotel in the end of the tour and you will have free time. Overnight at our hotel.

Orvieto tour: \$ 30

Day 5 | FLORENCE (Thursday, August 27, 2026)

After our breakfast at our hotel, you will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Pisa - Siena - San Gimignano tour. Siena is known as a city where the most intense artworks and the most expensive antique shops are located in Italy. Among the places, we will see in Siena are the Duomo Cathedral, Piazza del Campo, La Ragnosa Tower, the famous Palazzo del Popolo, which is now used as the Town Hall, and its narrow streets that still reflect all the traces of the past. After a trip at Siena, we will move to Pisa. After visiting the Leaning Tower of Pisa, the Cathedral, and Miracolo Square where the Baptistery is located, you will have free time. San Gimignano is a well-preserved medieval town. It is surrounded by walls. Its towers and narrow streets from the 12th and 13th centuries are used as souvenirs. It is an unforgettable town with its shops and magnificent vineyards. Transfer to the hotel, after the tour. Overnight at our hotel.

Pisa - Siena - San Gimignano tour: \$ 130

Day 6 | FLORENCE - VENICE (Friday, August 28, 2026)

After breakfast in our hotel, departure to Venice. We will arrive at Venice Tronchetto square on our bus. After our arrival, the meeting point is San Marco Square for our panoramic city tour. We will see granite columns with statues of San Teodoro were brought from Istanbul. Behind it, we will see the Basilica, the State church of the Republic. It was built between 1063 and 1073 in a mixture of European and Byzantine styles to preserve the bones of San Marco, one of the twelve apostles. Then we will see the Palace of the Dukes. A symbol of Venetian power and fame, the palace was at the same time both the residence of the Duke and the seat of the government. The arrangement of cute geometric shapes formed by white and pink marble gives the facade a fascinating expression. Big channel. About 2 km. In the long canal, 200 marble palaces belonging to the 12th - 18th centuries, where the 'Patricians' lived, are lined up side by side. Bell Tower, Clock Tower, Bridge of the Last Breath are among the places to see.

Our guests can join alternatively to the Gondola tour of Murano & Burano Tour. On the islands of Murano and Burano, located right next to Venice, we will have the opportunity to see the intricacies of the famous Murano glass processing and the unique houses of Burano. Transfer to the hotel, after the tour. Overnight at our hotel.

Day 7 | VENICE - MILAN (Saturday, August 29, 2026)

After breakfast in our hotel, departure to Milan. On the way to Milan, you can join alternatively to the Verona and Garda tour, we will see Verona, the city of dukes of northern Italy, which hosts the largest arena in Italy after the Colosseum in Rome, including the house of Romeo and Juliet, the subject of the greatest love story in history. Later, Lake Garda and Sirmione Village, one of the largest examples of the lakes region in northern Italy, are among the places we will see. After our tour, transfer to Milan.

Upon arrival Milan we will have panoramic city tour. Milan, the largest city in Italy. On the panoramic tour, we will see; Milan Castle 'Castello Sforzesco', which is one of the historical monuments of the city. Then the Cathedral of the Duomo where Gothic art can be seen intensely is the fourth largest church in the world with its exterior consisting of more than 2000 statuettes, the Fortezza castle, the largest shopping center of the Middle Ages, from the 18th century of industrial revolution La Galleria. Famous French engineer Gustave Eiffel inspired the construction of the Eiffel Tower in Paris from here. In addition, you will have the opportunity to wander the world-famous streets of this city, which is surrounded by famous shops in Milan. This city is the capital of fashion and art. Transfer to the hotel, after the tour. Overnight at our hotel.

Verona & Garda city and lake tour: \$ 70

Day 8 | MILAN (Sunday, August 30, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, we will leave the rooms and, you will have free time to explore the city sight until your flight or you can join alternatively to the Lugano and Lake Como tour, which accompanied by our tour leader and our private bus. First, we see the Lugano glacial lake, one of the natural wonders of Switzerland and Italy. Most of the lake is in Italy and a small part is in the Swiss part. Its longest point is 35 km, its widest point is 3.2 km, and its deepest point is 315 m. There are shipyards, water taxis, and boat rental units on the lake and its shores. In addition, there are countless hotels and restaurants. Lake Como, one of the natural wonders of Italy on the other hand, (Como, with an area of 146 square kilometers, is the third-largest lake in Italy after Garda and Maggiore. Although it may seem small at first glance, all the settlements around this long and forked lake are beautiful, peaceful, and calm. Each mansion is a work of art.
