Day 1 | HELSINKI (Sunday, May 10, 2026)

Well come to Helsinki! Capital of Finland, this amazing and elegant city welcomes you right from its heart! Your beautiful tour starts with meet and greet at the reception of the hotel where the tour leader will explain you the details and you get to meet your fellow travelers. Make sure your camera roll has enough space as every corner of the cities you're about to see will truly amaze you with its history and architecture. Finland is famous for being the happiest country in the world. Helsinki delights travelers with see facing landscape, world famous design and Nordic cuisine located everywhere you go, and you finally can see them with your own eyes. North Europe dream starts now!

This week you'll be taken care of by our professional tour leaders that will guide you through history, traditions and cuisine of this fabulous Nordic culture brought to us since the times of the Russian Empire.

After the tour meeting with your tour leader, you will have free time to explore the city sight. Overnight stay at our hotel.



Day 2 | HELSINKI (Monday, May 11, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, we will depart for a panoramic city tour. The Republic of Finland, surrounded by the Baltic Sea, the Gulf of Bothnia and the Gulf of Finland, is a Scandinavian country located in the northernmost part of Europe between Russia and Sweden. There is no city in Europe that is closer to nature and the sea than Helsinki. Helsinki is a city created by nature, sea and history. Among the places to be seen in our city tour first; Senate Square (Senaatintori) is the official center of the city. The Lutheran Church, carved in hard rock, was built by the architects Timo and Tuomo Soumenlainen. The Finnish National Museum (Kansallismuseo), which has a rich collection witnessing the history of Finland from the stone age to the present, the Helsinki Olympic Stadium and many museums in the city are among the places to be seen panoramically. After our city tour, we move on to the Suomenlinna castle, built on six islands. Suomenlinna fortress is a sea fort used as a residential area. The fortress, which is one of the UNESCO World Heritage Sites, is one of the main places to be seen in Helsinki with its locals, natural atmosphere, and picnic areas. End of tour return to our Rome hotel. Overnight stay at our hotel.



Day 3 | HELSINKI - TALLIN (Tuesday, May 12, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, departure to Tallin. After a 2-hour journey by ferry, we will arrive to Tallinn. We will have our panoramic city tour. Tallinn is the capital and main port city of Estonia. It is one of the oldest cities of the Middle Ages. The old town square, Toonmpea Castle, Dome Cathedral and Alexander Nevsky Cathedral are among the places to see on the Tallinn city tour. End of the tour, transfer to the hotel you will have free time to explore the city sight or alternatively, our guests can join Rocca Al mare alternative tour. Here, you will have the opportunity to visit, one of the few open-air museums. This tour is travel back to the rural Estonia of old in this vast, living museum filled with recreated, 18-20th century villages. The forested park comprises numerous thatched farm buildings as well as historic windmills, a wooden chapel, and a village school. Staff in period costume demonstrate how people lived and worked in times past. Visitors can buy handicrafts and try out the traditional foods served in the village tavern. Transfer to our hotel at the end of the tour. Overnight stay at our hotel

Day 4 | TALLIN - RIGA (Wednesday, May 13, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, departure to Riga. On the way to Riga, you can join alternatively to Parnu tour. We will go to seaside town of Parnu. Parnu is a city with a population of approximately 44 thousand located on the coast of the southwestern part of Estonia where the Parnu River empties into the Baltic Sea. You can buy your souvenirs here. Parnu is known as the summer capital of Estonia. It has a long, white sandy beach and is also famous for its hot springs. After our tour, we will continue to Riga. After arriving in Riga, we will go to our hotel. Overnight stay at our hotel.

Day 5 | RIGA (Thursday, May 14, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, panoramic city tour of Riga. Among the places to see on this tour are 14. The century-old Riga Castle was built in 1330, when the invading German Teutonic knights revolted, they destroyed the castle. In 1491, the castle was rebuilt, and its completion ended in 1515. Inside, two museums house the office and the president's residence. It is the symbol of Riga. St. Jacob's Church, Brotherhoods of the Blackheads House is the only Renaissance building built by the Blackheads Brothers in 1399. Famous for its interesting story, it attracts the attention of everyone, big and small. The Guildhalls and the House of Cats, the old city walls, the Dom Church, the theater and the House of Parliament are among the places to see.

After our tour you will have free time to explore the city sight or alternatively, our guests can join our Gauja National Park and Sigulda Castle tour. We are visiting the park, which is on the list of Gauja National Park International Society for Conservation of Nature. After visiting this nature, which is the largest national park of Latvia, we set out for Sigulda Castle. After our tour, transfer to our hotel and overnight stay at our hotel.

Day 6 | RIGA - VILNIUS (Friday, May 15, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, departure to Vilnius. On the way to Vilnius, you can join alternatively to the Jurmala, Hill of Crosses and Rundale palace tour. We will start with Jurmala, it is the coastal region with sandy beaches on the edge of the Baltic Sea and you will be amazed by its wooden houses in the forest. After Jurmala we will go to Rundale Palace tour. Rundale Palace is one of the most important works of Baroque and Rococo Art in Latvia and Europe. It was built by the famous Italian architect Rastrelli between 1736 and 1740 as the summer palace of the Duke of Courland, Ernst Jonann Biron. Then we will go to Hill of Crosses. It is the hill of the Cross and the exact origin of the practice of leaving the Crosses on the hill is unclear, we will continue our way after visiting this pilgrimage region. After our tour, we will continue our way to Vilnius. Transfer to our hotel. Overnight stay at our hotel. Jurmala, Rundale Palace, Hill of Crosses tour: \$ 130



Day 7 | VILNIUS (Saturday, May 16, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, we will depart for a panoramic city tour. The Lithuanians are descended from the Baltic peoples who settled in this region around 2500 BC. After the establishment of the Grand Duchy of Lithuania in the 16th century, he accepted Christianity, and when the king married the queen of Jogoila Poland (Polish to the Ottoman Poles), the two countries started a fateful union. Vilnius, which is on the UNESCO World Cultural Heritage List, is among the places to see in the city; St. Peter and Paul Church, Cathedral Square and Vilnius Cathedral, Cathedral Square and the city walls are among the places we will see. After our tour you will have free time to explore the city sight or alternatively, our guests can join our Trakai tour. Trakai is located in the Southwest of Lithuania, 28 km from the capital Vilnius. It is a historical and touristic city with a population of thousands. The city is surrounded by lakes named Lukos (Bernardinu), Totoriškiu, Galves, Akmenos, Gilušio in the Peninsula Region. There are 200 small and large lakes in the region. There are architectural, historical, and cultural monuments in the city of Trakai. Trakai castle is the best known castle in Lithuania. The castle was repaired in the 20th century. As there are historical films in the castle, other touristic promotional films are also shot today. There has been a museum inside the castle since 1962. At the end of the tour, transfer to our hotel and overnight at our hotel. Trakai tour: \$ 60



Day 8 | VILNIUS (Sunday, May 17, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, we will leave the rooms and, you will have free time to explore the city sight until your flight or alternatively you can join Minsk tour. On this tour, we will go to the capital of Belarus, Minsk city. We will be going to see, Peter and Paul church, Troitskoye, Independence Square, Government Building, Krasny Roman Catholic Church and Victory Square's built-in memory of the Second World War Heroes are among the places we will see. After the tour we will transfer to Vilnius airport for our flight to Helsinki. Arrival to Helsinki end of Kappa Tour services. Thank you for being a Kappa Tour guest and joining our tour.
