Day 1 | ISTANBUL (Sunday, February 8, 2026)

Day 4 | THESSALONIKI - ATHENS (Wednesday, February 11, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, departure for departure for Athens, the capital of Greece.

Orthodox monks built these monasteries, which are also on the UNESCO world heritage list, to retreat to seclusion and to be closer to God in the early periods of Christianity. Arrival in Athens after our tour. Following our arrival, our city tour begins. (Panoramic city tour can be done the next day depending on the road and weather conditions) Agora, Temple of Zeus (Panorama), Parliament Building, Syntagma - Omonia Squares, Presidential Palace, Prime Minister s Residence, Historical Olympic Stadium, Panepistimiou Boulevards, National Library, and Academy University are among the places to see. Day 5 | ATHENS (Thursday, February 12, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, you will have free time to explore the city sight. If you want you can join to or Acropolis tour, which is one of the most famous sites in the history of the world. We will visit the Dionysus Sanctuary and Dionysus Theater before we walk up the slope leading to the Acropolis monuments. Panoramic views of the city will be perfect for your Instagram posts and stories. During our tour, we will gain insight into the significance of the historic monuments of Acropolis including the Parthenon, the Erechtheion, the Propylaia, the Nike Temple as well as other significant sights of Athens including the Odeon of Herodes Atticus, the Ancient Agora, the National Observatory of Athens and the city s scenic hills, Filoppapos, Mars, and Pnyx. After the Acropolis visit, we will go to the south of Athens to see the famous Corinth channel.

The Corinth Channel is a six-kilometer waterway connecting the Aegean Sea and the Ionian Sea. Every year over 10,000 boats and cruise ships sail down the canal as not to navigate 400 km around Greece to get from one ocean to the other. After the tour, we will turn back to our hotel. Overnight at our hotel.

Alternatively, our guests can join Athens by night and tavern tour. On this tour, we will go to see Piraeus, Pasha Harbour, Alimos, and the Faliro districts of Athens. Then, free time to taste these delicious delicacies in the port of Piraeus, where the famous fishermen are. Then we will go to Greek Taverna which has includes dinner with limited drinks accompanied by surprises and shows.

After our tour, we move to Xanthi and upon our arrival in Xanthi, we see the historical texture dominated by the traces of the Ottoman Empire in our panoramic tour by bus. Transfer to our hotel. Overnight at our Xanthi hotel.



Day 7 | KAVALA - ISTANBUL (Saturday, February 14, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, departure to Istanbul. On the way, first we will make our panoramic city tour of Komotini. After our city tour, Alexandroupoli will be seen panoramically and then move to the Ipsala border gate. Following the passport and customs procedures, travel to Istanbul by following the Keşan - Tekirdağ - Silivri highway. After the lunch break in Tekirdağ (the opportunity to taste the famous Tekirdağ Meatballs), we will arrive to Istanbul. Overnight at our hotel.



Day 8 | ISTANBUL (Sunday, February 15, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, we will leave the rooms and, you will have free time to explore the city sight until your flight, or you can join alternatively to the tour of Dolmabahce Palace. Dolmabahce Palace is the last residence for Ottoman Sultans with 365 rooms and 22 saloons. It is famous for its great collection of European antiquity, furniture, and 4.5-ton chandelier. Dolmabahce Palace, a blend of various European architectural styles, was built between 1843-1856 by Karabet Balyan, the court architect of Sultan Abdulmecid. The three-storied palace built on a symmetrical plan has 285 rooms and 43 halls. The palace has survived intact with its original decorations, furniture, and silk carpets and curtains. It surpasses all other palaces in the world in wealth and magnificence. At the end of our tour, we will turn back to our hotel. The end of Kappa Tour services.
