## Day 1 | JOHANNESBURG (Sunday, February 8, 2026)

Welcome to South Africa! As known as “Rainbow Nation” this amazing country welcomes you right from the heart! Your beautiful tour starts with meet and greet at the reception of the hotel where the Tour Leader will explain you the details and you get to meet your fellow travelers. Make sure your camera roll has enough space as every corner of the cities you’re about to see will truly amaze you with its, culture, and nature. South Africa, in 1652, the Netherlands established the southern city of Cape Town, and Dutch farmers, called Boers, began settling in the areas around the city. In 1806, wars in Europe left the British in control of the Cape Town colony. In 1910, the British united four colonies in the region and created South Africa. Traces of South African culture is located everywhere you go, and realize you can see them with your own eyes finally. South Africa dream starts now!

This week you will be taken care of by our professional tour leaders who will guide you through safaris, traditions, and cuisine of this fabulous African culture.

After meeting with your tour leader, you will have free time to explore the city sight. Overnight at our hotel.



## Day 2 | JOHANNESBURG (Monday, February 9, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, we will depart for panoramic city tour. During the tour, we will see Nelson Mandelas House, visit downtown Houghton, Rosebank and Sandton. Then transfer to our hotel by our private bus. After settling in our hotel, you can visit and shop at Sandton City Nelson Mandela Square.

After the city tour you will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Gold Reef City tour. The tour begins with a narration of Johannesburgs gold history and continues with home visits of former miners. After seeing these houses, which were used from the 1800s to the mid-1900s, the 226-meter mine is descended and how the gold is extracted is explained. From here, it is passed to the hall where the gold is cast. While it was the richest mine in the world between 1926-1977, it was closed when it lost its profitability and became an excursion and amusement park in 1986. We go down 226 meters below the ground and tour the gold mine and see how the gold is melted and poured in the furnace above. In addition, we can experience a colorful and historical gold mine revival with its cafes, square and shops. The mine, where a total of 1.4 million tons of gold has been extracted to date, was closed because it was costly to go under 4000 meters, although there is much deeper gold. While there were 3 farmhouses in pre-gold Johannesburg, this city has now become South Africa’s largest cosmopolitan and wealthy city.

If you wish, you can have fun at the Gold City theme park after the tour. Transfer to the hotel in the end of the tour. Overnight at our hotel.

## Day 3 | JOHANNESBURG - SUN CITY (Tuesday, February 10, 2026)

After the breakfast at our hotel, departure to Sun City. On the way, you can join alternatively to the Lesedi Cultural Village tour with lunch. Lesedi is a cultural village where you can closely see the lifestyles, dances, customs and traditions of the black tribes living in South Africa. At the beginning of the tour, the history of black cultures will be explained with a video presentation, then we divide into small groups and enter the areas exhibiting the home life of the Zulu-Xhosa-Basotho and Pedi tribes. Then we watch cultural African dances. We will have our lunch with traditional African cuisine at Lesedi Cultural Village, which will be held in the region. Transfer to the hotel in Suncity, following the tour. You will have free time to explore the city sight. Overnight at our hotel.

## Day 4 | SUNCITY (Wednesday, February 11, 2026)

After the breakfast at our hotel, you will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Pilanesberg safari tour. During this tour we will be guests of the daily life of various wild animals living in a natural environment of volcanic formation among the mountains in Pilanesberg National Park, where we will have the opportunity to spend unique hours full of unforgettable memories in the natural nature during our safari trip with safari vehicles in Pilanesberg National Park.

During our trip, we will have the opportunity to see lions, leopards, elephants, buffaloes and hippos, which are defined as the Big Five, as well as 350 bird species, 65 reptiles and hundreds of different animal species; After the safari, we will go to Sun City for our panoramic city tour. Sun City is located in the steppes of South Africa's northwestern state, on the shore of a tranquil lake and surrounded by the majestic mountains of Pilanesberg. Sun City is unique among resorts with its many features combined. Every year, the magical Lost City attracts thousands of tourists, with its four and five-star hotels equipped with splendid sports and entertainment activities. Transfer to the hotel in the end of the tour. Overnight at our hotel.

## Day 5 | SUN CITY - JOHANNESBURG - CAPETOWN (Thursday, February 12, 2026)

After the breakfast at our hotel, departure to Sun City. On the way, you can join alternatively to the Drakenstein Lion Park tour. Here we will have the opportunity to see panthers and even the rare white lion and baby lions. We will have the opportunity to feed baby lions with a bottle of milk and take a walk with them in the company of the guards. We will go to play games with the panthers. Following the tour, departure to Johannesburg airport for our flight to Capetown. Upon our arrival in Cape Town, transfer to the hotel in the end of the tour. Overnight at our hotel.

## Day 6 | CAPE TOWN (Friday, February 13, 2026)

After the breakfast at our hotel, you will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Table Mountain, Franschoek Wine Valley and Stellenbosh Trip, which will be organized in the company of our guides and private vehicles. If the weather conditions are suitable, you can take the cable car to the top of Table Mountain at an altitude of 1087 m and let yourself be enchanted by this insatiable view. (If the weather conditions are not suitable for the ascent, the Botanical Garden will be visited.) After a lunch break in Franschoek town, we see cheetahs, the fastest animal in the world, on land at the Cheetah farm. We are going to Stellenbosch Town, which was founded in 1679. We will have the opportunity to taste wine in one of the historical vineyards in this town famous for its wines, oak trees and university. Transfer to the hotel in the end of the tour. You will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Cape of Good Hope tour. It was discovered in 1488 by Portuguese explorer Bartolomeu Dias. This place used to be Storms End. Some sources state that the name of the Cape of Storms was later changed to the Cape of Good Hope, as it might upset the morale of the sailors. During our trip, we will go to Cape of Good Hope National Park from the coastal road of Champmans Peak, visit Seal Island by boat, and see fur seals. We will see the region where the Indian Ocean and the Atlantic Ocean separate from each other. We will also have the opportunity to see African penguins. After seeing the worlds highest lighthouse with the funicular, we will have lunch at a local restaurant. After seeing the cute African penguins, we pass through Simon's Town, where the navy is located, and return to Cape Town. We will return to the hotel after the tour. Overnight at our hotel.

## Day 7 | CAPE TOWN (Saturday, February 14, 2026)

After the breakfast at our hotel, you will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Cape Peninsula tour or Great White Shark Cage Diving tour.

On our Cape Peninsula tour, we will depart for the most spectacular views. Drive to Cape Point at the southwestern tip of the Cape Peninsula, passing steep mountains, secluded coves, and sweeping beaches en route. After a stop at the fishing village of Hout Bay, one of Cape Towns best kept secrets, continue to the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve, comprising over 17,300 acres of indigenous flora and fauna, where you may see baboons by the roadside, the grey rhebok, Cape Mountain zebras, bontebok and the elusive eland. The native plant life, known as fynbos, forms one of only six floral kingdoms in the world. Following the coastline along False Bay, return to Cape Town by way of Simons Town. Here, visit the penguin colonies at Boulders Beach, and continue with a scenic drive over Muizenberg Mountain. Lastly, visit the Kirstenbosch National Botanical Gardens, resting at the foot of Table Mountain, for a short walking tour of the beautiful gardens before finally returning to Cape Town. We will return to the hotel after the tour. Overnight at our hotel.

On our Great White Shark Cage Diving tour, join a thrilling full day excursion to "Shark Alley" to experience great white shark cage diving. Early this morning departs Cape Town and head east to the coastal fishing town of Gansbaai. Upon arrival, the crew of your expedition boat will review the day's activities, safety etiquette and provide fascinating insight to these marine predators. Enjoy a light breakfast before boarding your boat and heading out into the open waters between Geyser Rock and Dyer Islander where great white hunt for seals and penguins. Outfitted with a wetsuit, lifejacket, and snorkeling mask, climb through the top of the cage secured to the boat. You will take turns with your fellow divers watching these predators under water and from the comfort of the ship deck. Return to the port in the early afternoon where you will be greeted with a hot bowl of soup and bread. Relax as the marine biologist recaps your adventure and answers any remaining questions before your return to Cape Town.

\*Departure from the hotel will be as early as 4 AM and the drive from Cape Town to Gansbaai is approximately 2.5 hours (one way). The boat will be launched around 9 AM and the boat trip will last between 3-5 hours depending on the weather and sea conditions. Shower facilities will be available after the ship returns from the dive. The return transfer to Cape Town will be at approximately 2 PM and arrival at 4:30 PM. Pick-up and drop-off times are approximate and will be advised locally. We will return to the hotel after the tour. Overnight at our hotel.
