Day 1 | MEXICO CITY (Saturday, February 7, 2026)

Welcome to Mexico City! As known as “Capital of the Imperio Mexicano” this amazing and elegant city welcomes you right from the heart! Your beautiful tour starts with meet and greet at the reception of the hotel where the Tour Leader will explain you the details and you get to meet your fellow travelers. Make sure your camera roll has enough space as every corner of the cities you’re about to see will truly amaze you with its history and architecture. Mexico can be said to have had seven major civilizations, The Olmec, Teotihuacan, the Toltec, the Aztec, Zapotec, Mixtec, and the Maya that they surrounded themselves with and it shows. A more fitting country could not have been designed by different civilizations. Get inspired by national treasures from Chichen Itza Pyramids to Caribbean costal and world famous historical art pieces located everywhere you go and realize you can see them with your own eyes finally. Mexican dream starts now!



This week you will be taken care of by our professional tour leaders who will guide you through history, traditions and cuisine of this fabulous culture brought to us since the times of the Aztecs.

Mexico City is the city that is the administrative center of Mexico, the capital city of the place under the sovereignty of Central America. Mexico City is also one of the 31 regions of Mexico, which is a country of independent countries. Mexico City is the largest and most famous city in Mexico, as well as the densest province of the partner state. The number of people who became a native of a place in Mexico City, resided and remained settled is approximately 21.2 million.

After the tour meeting with your tour leader, you will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Dinner show in Garibaldi Square tour, where Mariachi Street musicians gather in their traditional clothes. We will return to the hotel after the tour. Overnight at our hotel.

Day 2 | MEXICO CITY (Sunday, February 8, 2026)

After the breakfast at our hotel, we will depart for a city tour of Mexico City. Mexico City, which was founded by the Aztecs in the 1300s on Lake Texaco, one of the 5 interconnected lakes and the largest, and served as the capital of the Mexican Empire until the 15th century, is the center of modern art and architecture, politics, culture, as well as Aztec civilization and ancient times. It is also the center of the country in terms of education and finance. “Great Tenochtitlan” during the Aztecs; “respectable and noble imperial city” during the Spanish colonial period; Mexico City, which has been awarded different names such as the “city of palaces” with its abundance of ostentatious houses and buildings, has gained the title of a dizzying metropolis with its population of 20 million today.



During our city tour, Zocalo Square, which has been used for different purposes in the historical process from the Aztecs civilization to today. Sometimes hosts the inquisition court and sometimes peddlers, but is considered the brain of colonial history today, the Metropolitan Cathedral, which has the distinction of being the largest and oldest cathedral in the Americas, The National Palace, whose architectural structure has changed little since the Aztecs are among the places we will see. We will return to the hotel after city tour and in the afternoon, we will have free time to explore Mexico City. Overnight at our hotel.

Day 3 | MEXICO CITY (Monday, February 9, 2026)

After the breakfast at our hotel, you will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Teotihuacan Pyramids tour. During this tour, we will see the largest MESO American city of the time, reflecting the social and cultural heritage of the Aztecs. La Calzada de los Muertos, the Road of the Dead, on the south-north axis passing through the center of the city, which was arranged according to the classical architectural structure of the Aztecs, served as a ceremonial road. It is located at the southern end of the road to the Dead "Moon Pyramid - Piramide de la Luna". The two sides of the road are surrounded by platforms of the Moon and the remains of different structures. While its northern end is yet to be discovered, at its eastern end is the gigantic "Pyramid of the sun - "La Piramide del Sol".



The mysterious Teotihuacan, which is on the UNESCO World Heritage List, who was founded by and why it was suddenly abandoned, has a mythological significance in Aztec existence stories. Rumor has it that in the beginning there was darkness and silence, so all the Gods got together and lit a big bonfire. For the creation of the Sun and the Moon, 2 Gods who were sacrificed had to jump into the fire. The first god to jump into the fire was the sun, the second god was the moon - when the moon and the sun did not start to rotate, all the gods threw themselves into the fire. Thus, the Sun and Moon began to rotate. The name of the Sun and Moon Pyramids in Teotihuacan is based on this story. Could it be true to you - why not? On this platform, we will also see the Quetzalcoatl Temple, the Butterfly Palace, the Jaguar Temple. We will return to the hotel after the tour. Overnight at our hotel.

Day 4 | MEXICO CITY - CANCUN (Tuesday, February 10, 2026)

After the breakfast at our hotel, transfer to the airport for our flight to Cancun, which has the most beautiful coasts of the Caribbean Se. Upon our arrival, transfer to our hotel. Cancun means "The Nest of the Snakes" in the Mayan language. The city, which attracts 4 million tourists a year with its deep blue sea, white and fine sandy beaches, sun, entertainment and shopping stores, really deserves this attention. Overnight at our hotel.



Day 5 I CANCUN - CHICHEN ITZA MAYA TOUR (Wednesday, February 11, 2026)

After the breakfast at our hotel, you will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Chichen Itza Ancient City tour. Chichen Itza, which is on the List of the New 7 Wonders of the World and also on the UNESCO World Heritage List, has the distinction of being an ancient city with huge pyramids covering an area of ??300 hectares. Chichen Itza is a Maya city of Itza, founded in the pre-Columbian era, located between Valladolid and Mérida in Mexico's Yucatán Peninsula. It is known that between the 4th and 10th centuries AD, when the Maya Civilization was at its strongest, this place was also considered a religious center of the same power. Afterwards, the Toltecs took this city from the Mayans and the Mayans remained as tribes living in the mountains until the end of the 17th century. Chichen Itza means "The Mouth of the Well of the Itzas" in the Mayan language, and as can be understood from this, Itza indicates the existence of another indigenous tribe. During our tour, apart from the pyramids in Chichen Itza, the observatory called Caracol in the shape of a snail, which is the oldest structure of the ruins; The sacred well where the bodies sacrificed to the rain god ChaacMoola are thought to be thrown is located in the Cenote. During our tour, we take our lunch at a local restaurant. We will return to the hotel after the tour. Overnight at our hotel.

Day 6 I CANCUN - HAVANA (Thursday, February 12, 2026)

After the breakfast at our hotel, transfer to the airport for our flight to Havana. Upon arrival we will start our panoramic Havana city tour. During our tour, we will visit Havana Old Town, Malecon Boulevard, Revolution Square, Columbus Cemetery, which are on the UNESCO World Heritage List. After the lunch break, we continue to follow the traces of the past in the city, which is the first name of the city founded by the Spanish, San Cristobal de la Habana, which was later shortened to La Habana. The places we will see are Miramar and Morro Castle, where you can watch the city from a birds eye view. Havana, named after San Cristobal de la Habana, was founded by the Spanish. We would like to bring to your attention the places we will see in our city tour, passing through the modern Havana, Artdeco and Vedado Region mixed with modern architecture, and the world-famous Revolution Square, Plaza de Armas, Plaza de la Catedral, Plaza Vieja and Plaza de San Francisco de Asis by walking step by step and passing the old streets. Old people with cigars in their mouths will wave at us, watching us from broken balconies with hung clothes. You can take lots of photos. Your most valuable photos will be black and white, if you feel like you have traveled back in time. La Bodeguita del Medio and Floridita Bar will remind you of the famous Ernest Hemingway.



Bolero, Chachas, Maraca rhythm will arise from within us. The old city of the capital, which is on the UNESCO's list of sites, can easily be called a musical paradise. It is possible for a tourist to come across live music bands in almost every cafe, street, bar, hotel and restaurant he goes to in Havana. So much so that one is sometimes surprised by the abundance of quality Latin bands that one finds the opportunity to listen to in their own country, and then they better understand that music is an indispensable part of life for a Cuban. You can buy oil paintings and crafts from the market.

Transfer to the hotel after the tour. You will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the famous Tropicana night show tour with dinner, which carries the glory of the 60s in the revolutionary free city of Cuba. This world famous Cabaret Show will give us an unforgettable night with a crowded dance and music staff; Cuba will warm us with dances and music. We will return to the hotel after the tour. Day 7 | HAVANA (Friday, February 13, 2026)

After the breakfast at our hotel, you will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Santa Clara, Che Guevera, Varadero tour. We will go to Santa Clara to experience the monument and sad story of Che Guevera, the most romantic symbol of Cubas human history, revolution and all world revolutions. Our first stop in Santa Clara is where the wagons that changed the fate of the revolution are located. Because the living witnesses of what happened in Santa Clara are the wagons here. The biggest blow to Batista during the revolution was experienced when the soldiers under the command of Che Guevara seized the train loaded with weapons and captured Batista soldiers, who were outnumbered by them. Our tour continues with a visit to the Chenin monument. Please dont sayl visited Cuba without seeing this monument, which contains the graves of Che Guevara and 38 of his friends, and saying hello to Che. The fire that Castro lit in 1997 in the burial chamber still burns today and Chen has his personal belongings. Our Santa Clara tour is in front of the Comite Provincial building We return to Havana after listening to his story in front of the statue of Che Guevara, which was made with a magnificent craftsmanship. We will return to the hotel after the tour. Overnight at our hotel.
