Day 1 | SKOPJE (Sunday, February 8, 2026)

Welcome to Skopje! As known as “City of statues” this amazing and elegant city welcomes you right from the heart! Your beautiful tour starts with meet and greet at the reception of the hotel where the Tour Leader will explain you the details and you get to meet your fellow travelers. Make sure your camera roll has enough space as every corner of the cities you're about to see will truly amaze you with its history and architecture. Balkan's love is surrounded themselves with beauty and it shows. A more fitting region could not have been designed by different cultures. Get inspired by national treasures from Macedonia Square to neoclassical city center and world famous art pieces located everywhere you go and realize you can see them with your own eyes finally. Balkan dream starts now!



This week you will be taken care of by our professional tour leaders who will guide you through history, traditions and cuisine of this fabulous Balkan culture brought to us since the times of the Empires.

After the tour meeting with your tour leader, we will go for Skopje panoramic city tour with our guide and private vehicles.

Clock Tower, Turkish Bazaar, Mustafa Pasha Mosque, Capan Han, Sulu Han, Stone Bridge. We will walk by watching the old Turkish and Jewish quarters on the side of the river. We will see Macedonia Square, the Ottoman Bridge and Davut Pasha Bath. Then we will go to the old Turkish bazaar and start to see the historical artifacts, where 17 inns were built during the Ottoman period, only 3 inns remain today. After seeing Kursunlu Han and Kapan Han, built in the second half of the 15th century, we will see the clock tower, one of the symbolic works of Skopje and built in the 16th century, and the Sultan Murat Mosque, built in the 14th century.

Following the tour, you will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Matka Canyon tour. On this tour, we will have a pleasant walk accompanied by the nature view. Transfer to the hotel, after the tour. Overnight at our hotel.

Day 2 | SKOPJE - KALKANDELEN - GOSTIVAR - OHRID (Monday, February 9, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, departure to Kalkandelen. Tetovo is in the northwest of Macedonia, within the borders of the Polog Region. It is built on the skirts of Sharr Mountain and by the Pena River. It is the third largest city in the country after the capital Skopje and Monastery. In the 14th century, Tetovo, like many other cities in the region, joined the Ottoman Empire. With the Turkish domination, many changes and innovations were seen in the city. In the city, which started to develop in terms of trade, new buildings, and structures such as baths were established. This period also enabled the Muslim population in Tetovo to increase and become the dominant population. In connection with the situation in question, many mosques, masjids, and religious buildings were established in the city. Alaca Mosque, built in 1438, is



important in many ways. During the Ottoman Empire, Tetovo was not only an important trade center, but also came to the fore in terms of agriculture and craft. In addition to these, the city also had the feature of a military base. With the declaration of independence of Macedonia from the Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia in 1991, Tetovo has come to the present day within the independent Republic of Macedonia. Among the places to see in and around Tetovo decorated by the Pena River, the old castle, the Lešok Monastery, the historical stone bridge, the Alaca Mosque, an original architectural work built in the 1400s with its colorful decorations, the old Turkish Bath serving as an art gallery by the Pena River, are available. Then we continue our tour with Gostivar. Arrival in Ohrid in the end of the tour. Then we start our panoramic tour of Struga. Transfer to the hotel, after the tour. Overnight at our hotel.

Day 3 | OHRID (Tuesday, February 10, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, you will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the St. Naum, Resne, Monastery tour with lunch. During this tour we will see, one of the most important saints Monastery of Macedonia, Naum Monastery. Then we will go to Resne. Here we will visit the Palace of Niyazi of Resne, one of the three most famous figures of the Union and Progress, which became famous for its benefits in the Turkish - Greek war. Then, during our Manastir (Bitola) city tour, we will see the old Turkish Bazaar, Bedesten. We will depart for Ohrid city after the tour. Upon arrival, we will make panoramic city tour. We will see the most important church of the Byzantine period in Ohrid, St. Panteleymon, the Hagia Sophia Church, which is still used for concerts today, and the Roman-era amphitheater, Car Samuel Castle, St. Bogorodica Perivlerta, century churches and Emin Mahmut Mosque, Cinar Square.

We will return to the hotel following the tour and you will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Macedonian Night tour with dinner and music. You will taste the Balkan cuisine and experience an unforgettable night. Transfer to the hotel, after the tour. Overnight at our hotel.

Day 4 | OHRID - TIRANA - SHKODER (Wednesday, February 11, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, departure to Shkoder. Our first stop on the way to Shkoder is Tirana, the capital of Albania. Ethem Bey Mosque, historical Clock Tower, National Museum, Opera and Ballet Building, Parliament and Prime Ministry Buildings, Presidential Palace and Skanderberg Square are among the places to see. We will continue to Shkoder after the tour. Overnight at our hotel.



Day 5 | ISKODRA - BAR - ST. STEFAN - BUDVA - KOTOR - TREBINJE (Thursday, February 12, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, departure to Trebinje. Our first stop will be Bar. Our second stop; the magnificent St. Stefan, which was sold to a multi-billionaire from Singapore after the nationalization of an island that was formerly a settlement for fishermen. You can see St. Stefan's beautiful view from the top. After a break, our third stop is Budva, one of the most famous holiday centers of the Balkans with its magnificent beaches and colorful nightlife. On the walking tour we will do here, we will visit Stari Grad (old city center) and the castle. Afterwards, we make our Kotor tour; We are entering Montenegro, one of the youngest countries in the world, the pearl of the Adriatic Sea. Then we move to Kotor, which is an important historical and natural paradise and tourist attraction center.

Transfer to the hotel after the tour. In the evening, our guests can join alternatively to the Dubrovnik tour. Transfer to the hotel in the end of the tour. Overnight at our hotel.

Day 6 | TREBINJE - POCITEL - BLAGAJ - MOSTAR - SARAJEVO (Friday, February 13, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, departure to Sarajevo. Our first stop is Počitelj. Which is protected with its historical texture and known as the Turkish Village. Our second stop is Blagaj which is one of the most valuable urban and rural areas of Bosnia and Herzegovina. Then we continue to Mostar. First, we will see the Mostar Bridge on our walking tour in Mostar. Built by the architect Hayreddin in 1556, the bridge is a masterpiece of Ottoman architecture. The bridge was destroyed by the Croatian artillery in the war that took place in 1992, but it was reopened in 2004 with the great contributions of the Republic of Turkey. We will also see the Koska Mehmet Pasha Mosque. Then we will drive to Sarajevo. Upon our arrival in Sarajevo, we will start our panoramic city tour. Bascarsija, the most exclusive bazaar in Europe. We will see Kurşunlu Madrasa, which has been operating since the Ottoman period. Then we will see the Clock tower, the Catholic Cathedral in Sarajevo, the Orthodox Churches, and the Jewish Synagogue. Then, the Latin Bridge, where World War I broke out. Transfer to the hotel following the tour. In the evening, you can join alternatively to the Bosnian Night tour with dinner and music. Transfer to the hotel after the tour. Overnight at our hotel.

Day 7 | SARAJEVO - BELGRADE (Saturday, February 14, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, departure to Belgrade. Upon arrival in Belgrade, we will start our panoramic city tour. Castle Square, Military Museum, Istanbul Gate, Clock Tower, Damat Ali Pasha Tomb, Sokullu Mehmet Pasha Fountain, Stefan Lazarevic Monument, Nebojsa Tower, Saborna Church, Republic Square, Libra Square and Stone Square are among the places to see.

Following the tour, you will have free time to explore the city sight, or you can join alternatively to the Zemun and Titos tomb, Sava, and Danube ship tour. On this tour, we are going to Zemun first. In Zemun, we will see the mansions of the Austro - Hungarian period, the bazaar, the street of taverns, the old theater and the Zemun park. Then we will see the mausoleum of Marasel Tito, the founder of Yugoslavia, of Croatian origin. Then we will go to Sava and Danube cruise. Transfer to the hotel after the tour. Overnight at our hotel.

Day 8 | BELGRADE (Sunday, February 15, 2026)

After breakfast at our hotel, we will leave the rooms and, you will have free time to explore the city sight until your flight or alternatively, or you can join alternatively to the Novi Sad and Petrovaradin Castle tour. During this tour, we will go to Novi Sad, the capital of the Voivoda State. We will see the Petrovaradin Castle. Then we will go to the center of Novi Sad. Freedom Square, Svetozar Miletic Statue, Catholic Cathedral, Orthodox Aya Yorgi Cathedral, Aya Nikola Church and Synagogue are among the places to be seen during our walking tour in the city.
